

Program Details: The program started with a virtual lamp lighting ceremony and a welcome address.





In this webinar Dr Satyaki Sengupta discussed about the collaborative Transdisciplinary approach of Early Intervention setup. He also explained about the crucial role that physiotherapy play during acute, sub acute and outdoor EI settings in assessing and giving therapy of a child with various clinical conditions. He also described about interdisciplinary and transdisciplinary care model and how educational plan of a child will help to decide the therapeutic treatment plan in later time. He has also described about few assessment tools which therapist can use to evaluate a child in various parameter, which may help in determining the effectiveness of therapy sessions.
