



Inaugural address by Dr.P.K Lenka, Assistant Professor & HOD of Prosthetics & Orthotics Department, ADT, NILD, Kolkata

The Inaugural Speech was given by **Dr.P.K Lenka, Assistant Professor & HOD of Prosthetics & Orthotics Department & ADT, NILD, Kolkata** and he described about the importance of speech and language development and how much important speech therapy is for communication and overall development of a child.

Mr. Indranil Chatterjee, senior faculty in Audiology & Speech pathologist, AYJNISHD, RC, Kolkata: The Guest Speaker Mr. Indranil Chatterjee started his presentation with some pictorial and video-graphical description on multimodal therapy of child and child directed speech therapy with collaboration of Speech therapy, Physiotherapy, Occupational Therapy. He also showed a Bengali manual on self talk, parallel talk, and toy talk along with the description and how these helps in neuro-plasticity. He also elaborated about modelling, scaffolding, vocabulary listing and fast mapping of novel word acquisition. Lastly he showed a video on a success story of a child who undergone cochlear implantation and the effectiveness of speech rehabilitation on the child.




Ms. Arpita Chatterjee, Asst. Professor (Speech & Hearing),SGRDUHS, Amritsar

Mrs. Arpita Chatterjee, Assistant professor (Speech and Hearing) at SGRDUHS, Amritsar: Ms. Arpita Chatterjee started her discussion with reasons of delay in language development, definition of communication, type of communication, importance of communication, mechanism of sound

production and process of speech development along with few pictures. She also described about the speech chain and the speaker listeners relationship. Ms. Arpita Chatterjee described few techniques and methods in details about the process of speech development. She elaborated about the unique role of playing in development of speech and the hazards of under development of speech. She finally described about the factors responsible for swallowing impairment and tips for management of this.

The discussion was end with the question answer session with parents and participants.
